

## **Urgent Field Safety Notice**

#### Affected devices:

This condition is present on all Affinity® Birthing Beds manufactured before October 18, 2007. Affinity beds manufactured with serial number I290AA7395 or greater are not impacted by this correction.

#### **Background:**

Hill-Rom has become aware of a potential safety issue involving the labor grip on all Affinity® Birthing Beds. A non-powered shear point has been identified with the labor grip. Hill-Rom has received one report of permanent injury with this condition.

The shear point is created by a 3/8" slot on the labor grip rotation mechanism, which is under the upper surface of the frame near the seat section of the bed inside of the labor grip housing.

With the labor grip in both the stored and use positions, the slot in the labor grip mechanism is visible through a hole in the labor grip housing. As the labor grip is rotated from the stored to the use position—or vice versa—the mechanism rotates inside the labor grip housing allowing the hole to become open then closed, thus creating a shearing point between the labor grip housing and the labor grip mechanism.

#### Action to be taken by the user:

Our records indicate that your facility purchased one or more Affinity® Birthing Beds manufactured before October 18, 2007. In order to facilitate the implementation of the labor grip correction with minimal disruption to your facility, the following actions are to be taken:

- Hill-Rom will provide a free upgrade kit for all of your Affinity® Birthing Beds. The kit includes
  two machined plugs per bed to insert into the hole, an insertion tool, and full written instructions
  to assist in the upgrade of the labor grips. The upgrade kit(s) will be addressed and shipped to
  your Biomedical/Clinical Engineering department in the near future. Please complete and
  return the attached form to facilitate delivery to the correct person or department.
- The upgrade should be performed on all Affinity® Birthing Beds manufactured before October 18, 2007, by your facility qualified personnel for the performance of maintenance activities. The upgrade should take approximately 10 minutes per bed.
- Upon request, Hill-Rom will provide training and assistance with this correction. In the interim period, you may continue to use your Affinity® Birthing beds.

If you have relocated the Affinity® Birthing beds to another location or if the beds have been sold or removed from service, please advise us immediately so we can take the appropriate steps to complete this action.

We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause your facility. We understand that our products and services are an integral part of many medical facilities, and are aware of the impact that any disruption may have on the facility and its caregivers' ability to care for their patients. Be assured that our first priority is to provide you with the high quality, safe and reliable products you have come to expect from us. We appreciate your patience and cooperation.
